Description of Incident: The Caretaker Committee Chairman of Takum LGA in Taraba State was reportedly abducted and his police orderly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Wukari/Takum Road in Wukari/Takum LGA of Taraba State.

Location: Wukari/Takum Road in Wukari/Takum LGA of Taraba State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male abducted, one police officer killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/comuninity resident and a police officer.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

📍 **Description of Incident:** Sixteen (16) people were allegedly killed in a violent clash between suspected cult gangs 'Klaans and Black Axe' confraternities at Nwanniba Area in Uyo LGA of Akwa Ibom State.Preliminary investigations have revealed that the clash occurred following a supremacy tussle over control of a minibus park in the area.

📍 **Casualty [Male&female]:** Sixteen males killed.

📍 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected cult members.
