Date of Occurrence:30/4/2023

Description of Incident: A lawyer was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at his chambers around Warri Main Market of Delta State.Kidnapping for ransom has largely been attributed as the motive behind the criminality in the State.

Location: Warri Main Market of Delta State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One male abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population:No property damaged/lawyer.

Coping Mechanism/Responses:The swift response of security operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victim.

Property damaged/Affected population:No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
