STATISTICS OF INCIDENTS AND FATALITIES IN NIGERIA

JUNE 1 - 15, 2023



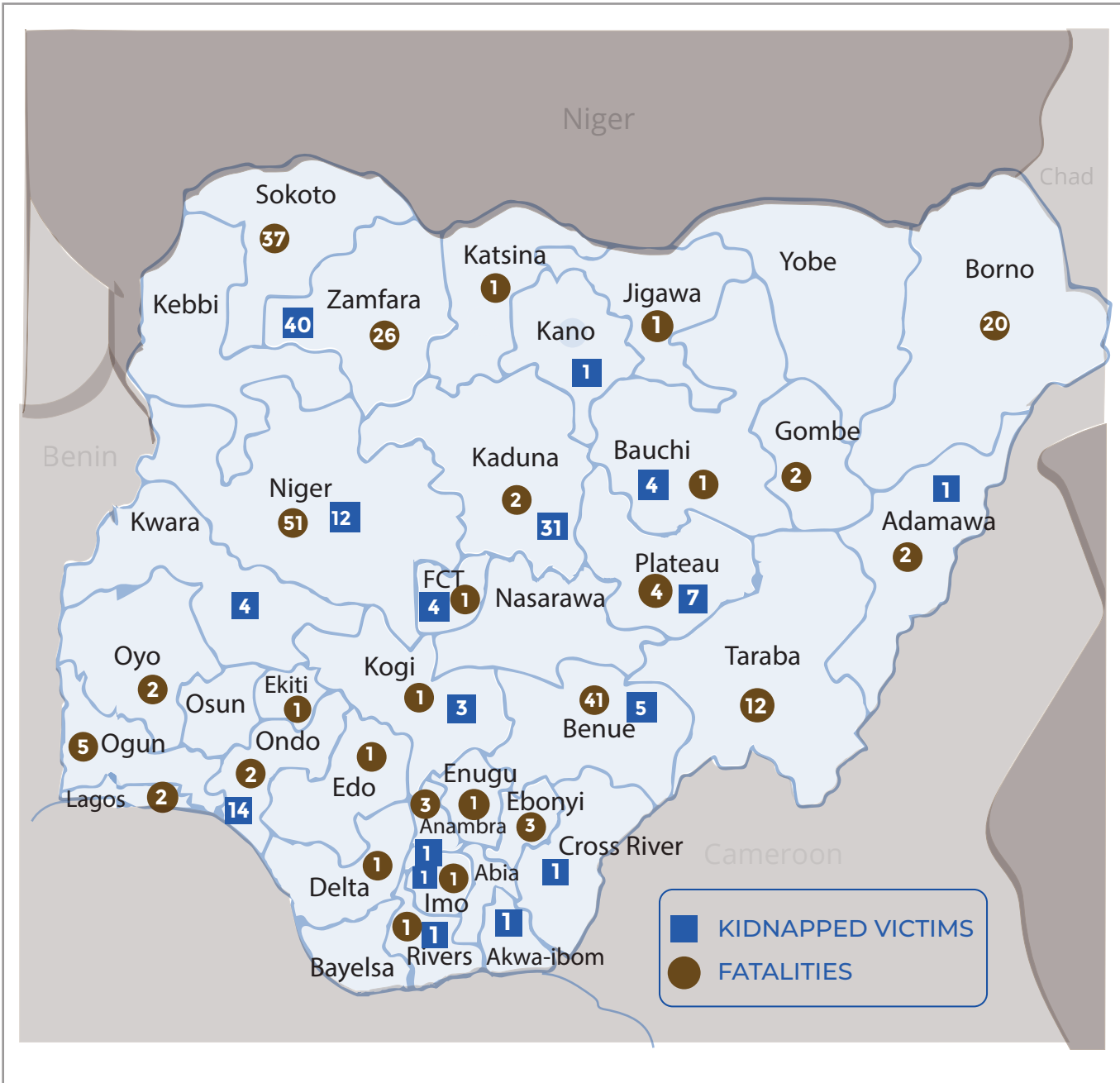
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, communal clashes including community/herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

Within the reporting period, a total of 64 armed violence incidents were recorded with 40 injuries and 219 fatalities including 10 women, 3 children and 20 security personnel. The North-Central had the highest number of fatalities with 98, while the North-West and North-East recorded 66 and 37 deaths respectively. The South-East, South-West and South-South accounted for the lowest fatalities of 8, 7 and 3 deaths in the reporting period.

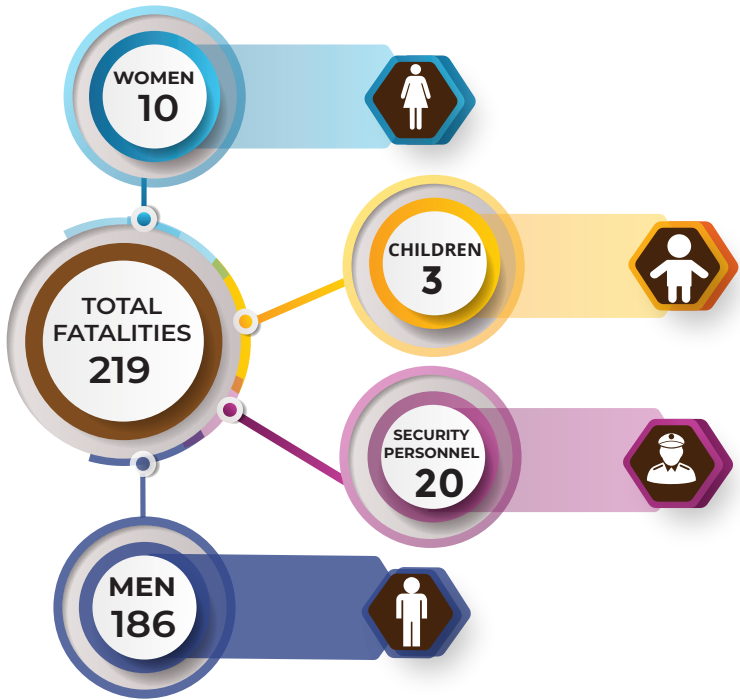
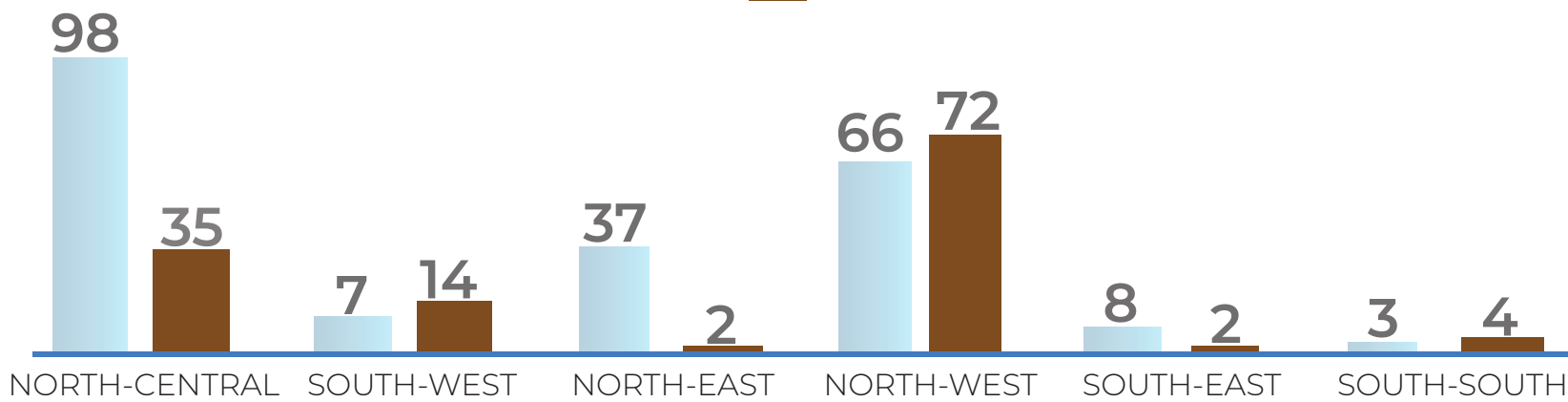
The WANEP NEWS also recorded 26 incidents of kidnapping across 17 States with 132 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 132 kidnapped victims, 37 were women, 6 children and 2 security personnel. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central accounted for the highest number with 72 and 35 victims, followed by the South-West and North-East with 14 and 5 kidnapped victims. The South-South and South-East had the lowest figures of 4 and 2 respectively.

AFFECTED LOCATIONS

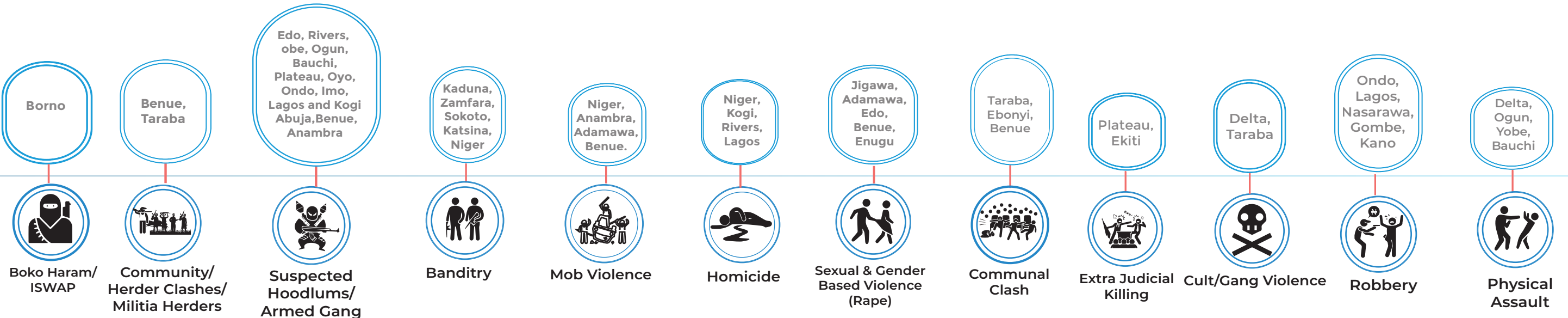


FATALITIES PER REGION (219)
