Title of Incident: ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 11/6/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a male suspect at Mongoro Forest in the FCT-Abuja for his alleged involvement in the supply of illicit drugs, firearms and ammunition to criminal gangs. Further investigation has revealed that the suspect is a logistics supplier and informant to banditry and kidnapping group in the FCT and its environs. Three AK-47 rifles, 32 live ammunition, six locally made firearms, and an unregistered motorcycle was recovered from the suspect.

Location: Mongoro Forest in the FCT.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damage/criminal suspect.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further investigation.

Title of Incident: ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 11/6/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested eleven (11) criminal suspects over illegal possession, fabrication and production of small arms and light weapons as well as armed robbery in Zuba Area, Gwagwalada Area Council of FCT-Abuja. Four locally made firearms and one live cartridge was recovered from the suspects.

Location: Zuba Area in Gwagwalada Area Council of the Federal Capital Territory (FCT).
