- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 18/6/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: A community resident was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at Nyivu Community in Donga LGA of Taraba State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Nyivu Community in Donga LGA of Taraba State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations to arrest the perpetrators of the crime.

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 18/6/2023
