**Description of Incident:** One (1) person was allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Kwi Community in Riyom LGA of Plateau State. Further investigations have revealed that the attack occurred after the victim resisted herders from grazing on his farmland.

**Location:** Kwi Community in Riyom LGA of Plateau State.

**Casualty [Male&female]:** One male killed.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attack in the affected area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attack in the affected area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
