### Incident N\*01:

- **▼ Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK**
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 28/5/2023
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed fifty-five (55) suspected Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) terrorists during security clearance operation at their hideouts in Arege Axis of Malam Fatori, Abadam LGA of Borno State. Also, four (4) military officers were allegedly killed and three (3) others injured in the incident. Several properties including vehicles, motorcycles were destroyed in the incident.
- **Location:** Arege Axis of Malam Fatori, Abadam LGA of Borno State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Fifty-nine people (including 55 ISWAP terrorists and 4 military officers) killed, three military officers injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/suspected ISWAP terrorists and military officers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the state to strengthen peace and security in the area.

### Incident N\*02:

- **♣** Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY A POLICE OPERATIVE
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 28/5/2023
- **Description of Incident:** A male resident was reportedly killed by stray bullets fired by a police officer at Oregun Axis in Ikeja LGA of Lagos State. Further investigations have revealed that the victim was hit by stray bullets as police operatives were attempting to dispersed the crowd in the area.
- Location: Oregun Axis in Ikeja of Lagos State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No casualty reported/community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:**The security operatives have commenced investigations to unravel the motive behind the shooting.

### Incident N\*03:

- **Title of Incident: BOMB EXPLOSION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 28/5/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly killed and a house destroyed in a bomb explosion planted by an unidentified criminal gang at Keffi Metropolis in Keffi LGA of Nasarawa State.
- Location: Keffi Metropolis in Keffi LGA of Nasarawa State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: One house destroyed/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Location: Agala Axis of Ogbakiri Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:**The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attack in the affected area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

#### Incident N\*05:

- Title of Incident: INVATION OF RADIO STATION BY YORUBA NATION AGITATORS/PHYSICAL ASSAULT
- **♣ Scale of incident:**Low
- Date of Occurrence: 28/5/2023
- Description of Incident: Five (5) suspected Yoruba Nation Agitators reportedly invaded a radio station belonging to the Federal Radio Corporation of Nigeria (FRCN) at Moniya Area in Akinyele LGA of Oyo State. The attackers reportedly seized the live studio while a sponsored programme was ongoing. Also, one of the arrested agitators sustained gunshot injuries in the incident. Preliminary investigations have revealed that the attackers reportedly threatened staff members to remove all Nigeria flags in the radio station and replace them with Yoruba Nation flags.
- Location: Moniya Area in Akinyele LGA of Ibadan, Oyo State.
- **Casualty [Male&female]:** One male injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected Yoruba Nation agitors.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The police operatives reportedly arrested (5) suspects in conection with the crime.

### Incident N\*06:

- Title of Incident: MURDER
- Scale of incident: Low
- ♣ Date of Occurrence: 28/5/2023
- → **Description of Incident:** A community chief was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by a motorcyclist at Irese Community in Ifedore LGA of Ondo State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Irese Community in Ifedore LGA of Ondo State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the suspect in connection with the crime.

### Incident N\*07:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK
- **Scale of incident:** Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence**:28/5/2023
- **Description of Incident:** A 13-year-old male was reportedly stabbed to death by two (2) male residents over robber slippers ownership at Iganmu Area in Surulere LGA of Lagos State.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) has continued the vaccination exercise of citizens and residents across the States in Nigeria.
