- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 4/6/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested two (2) suspected motorcycle thieves at Ozoro Town in Isoko North LGA of Delta State. Also, four (4) stolen motorcycles were recovered from the suspects.
- **Location:** Ozoro Town in Isoko North LGA of Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected motorcycle thieves.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

Arms, ammunition and several logistics supplies were recovered in the incident.
- Location: Bale, Tirke, Mandari and Molgoi Areas in Damboa and Chibok LGAs of Borno State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eleven ISWAP terrorists killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected ISWAP terrorists.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorist attacks in the state.

- ♣ Description of Incident: A protocol officer to erstwhile Chief of Staff at the Rivers State Government House was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Isiodu Community in Emohua LGA of Rivers State. The motive behind the crime is unknown.
