Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED MILITIA

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 16/7/2023

Description of Incident: Six (6) people were allegedly killed in separate attacks carried out by suspected armed militia at Gba-Ukyor and Tse Baka Communities in the Ushongo LGA of Benue State.

Location: Gba-Ukyor and Tse Baka Communities in Ushongo LGA of Benue State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Six males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the affected communities and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Title of Incident: HOMICIDE/ARREST

Scale of incident:Low

Date of Occurrence: 16/7/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a male suspect for allegedly killing his mother at Itanrin Axis in Ijebu Ode of Ogun State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

Location: Ijebu Ode of Ogun State.

Casualty [Male&female]: One female killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses:The arrested suspect is in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

Incident N*03:

Title of Incident: ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 16/7/2023

Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Mpape Area, of FCT-Abuja. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

Location: Mpape Area of Abuja-FCT.

Casualty [Male&female]: Two males abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of the security operatives led to the rescue of the abducted victims.

Title of Incident: MURDER

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 16/7/2023

Description of Incident: A Councillor representing Eha-Ulo Ward in Nsukka LGA of Enugu State was allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums at his residence in Eha-Alumonah Area Nsukka LGA of Enugu State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.

Location: Eha-Alumonah Area in Nsukka LGA of Enugu State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Twenty-two suspected armed bandits killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:**No property damaged/suspected armed bandits.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter armed bandits attacks in the state..

✚ **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS**

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/7/2023

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) traditional rulers were reportedly killed in seperate attacks carried out by suspected hoodlums at their palace in Nguru, Aboh and Ezinihitte Areas in Mbaise LGA of Imo State. The motive behind attack is unkown.

✚ **Location:** Nguru Axis, Aboh and Ezinihitte Areas in Mbaise LGA of Imo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two males killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/traditional rulers.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*07:

✚ **Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/ARREST**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/7/2023

✚ **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed two (2) suspected members of the Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB) and arrested five (5) others with several arms and ammunition recovered during a security raid at Fuji Junction General Area in Asaba Axiof Delta State.

✚ **Location:** Fuji Junction General Area in Asaba Axis of Delta State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Two suspected IPOB members killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** several arms and ammunition recovered/IPOB members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The arrested suspects are in the custody of the operatives of the Nigerian Army for further interrogation.

Incident N*08:

✚ **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 17/7/2023

✚ **Description of Incident:** Nine (9) people including a female were allegedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Jesse-Oben-Asaba Road of Delta State.The attackers reportedly intercepted a commercial bus in the incident. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.

✚ **Location:** Jesse-Oben-Asaba Road of Delta State.

✚ **Casualty [Male&female]:** Nine people (one female and 8 males) abducted.

Also, the Kaduna State government has alerted citizens on the outbreak and directed the Ministry of Health to send an emergency team to investigate cases and take immediate action reports.
