Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 25/6/2023

Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by community youths over allegations of blasphemy against the personality of Prophet Mohammad (SAW)- the name of an Islamic prophet at Sokoto metropolis abattoir in Kwanni Axis, Sokoto South LGA of Sokoto State.

Location: Kwanni Axis in Sokoto South LGA of Sokoto State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area.

Description of Incident: A vigilante group leader was reportedly killed and (2) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Danmusa LGA of Katsina State.
