Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/7/2023

Description of Incident: Two (2) police officers were allegedly killed and their patrol vehicle set ablaze in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums along Ughelli-Asaba Road in Oleh roundabout of Delta State. Two (2) rifles belonging to the police operatives were reportedly stolen in the incident.

Location: Ughelli-Asaba Road in Oleh roundabout of Delta State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two police officers killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Police patrol vehicle set ablaze and two rifles stolen/police operatives.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 23/9/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested a suspected cult member during a security raid at a hotel in Awka Axis of Anambra State.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/ suspected cult member.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

A counter-insurgency expert in the Lake Chad region reportedly disclosed that the ISWAP terrorists have placed a ban on fishing farming and grazing activities in their hideouts¹
