Incident N*1:

Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/7/2023

Description of Incident: Several traders were reportedly assaulted with goods worth millions of naira destroyed by operatives of the Nigerian Army at Holy Ghost and Old Park Areas in Enugu North LGA of Enugu State while enforcing the State Government’s directive on the closure of some markets.

Location: Holy Ghost and Old Park Areas in Enugu North LGA of Enugu State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Several traders injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties destroyed/traders.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the Nigerian Army have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected areas.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: BURGLARY/LOOTING/ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/7/2023

Description of Incident: Grain stores including four (4) warehouses managed by the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) and several private businesses were reportedly vandalized by community residents with several food and non-food items looted at Yola Axis in Adamawa State. . The raids were allegedly triggered by economic hardship and hunger induced by the increase in fuel price and its corresponding effect on other commodities. Stray bullets fired by security operatives deployed to disperse the looters during the raid led to the death of five (5) suspected hoodlums¹.

Location: Yola Axis in Adamawa State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Five males killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several warehouses and stores damaged/NEMA, traders.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Government has imposed a 24-hour curfew to strengthen peace and security across the State. The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to maintain peace and security. Also, the operatives of the State Police Command have arrested 45 suspects involved in the vandalization of warehouses and recovered looted items.

Incident N*3:

Title of Incident: SHOOTING

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 30/7/2023

Description of Incident: One (1) person was reportedly killed and one (1) other injured by stray bullets fired by security operatives during a demolition exercise on shanties and illegal structures in Owerri West LGA of Imo State. The exercise which led to the destruction of properties was coordinated by officials of the Owerri Capital Development Authority (OCDA) and the Environmental Transformation
