- Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a traditional ruler (Emir of Gurku) and his wife were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Gurku Town in Karu LGA of Nasarawa State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Gurku Town in Karu LGA of Nasarawa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two people (1 male, 1 female) abducted
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Emir of Gurku and wife.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed for search and rescue operations.
