- ♣ Description of Incident: Community residents reportedly invaded a storage warehouse and looted palliatives along Isaac Boro Road in Yenagoa LGA of Bayelsa State. The palliatives (including food items) were stored in the facility during the 2022 flood disaster in the State.
- Location: Isaac Boro Road in Yenagoa LGA of Bayelsa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: State Government palliative warehouse looted/Bayelsa State Government.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
