- Title of Incident: COMMUNAL CLASH/ ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 29/10/2023
- Description of Incident: Twenty (20) people including a military operative were allegedly killed and several others injured in a renewed communal clash between Yache-Ijiegu Community in Yala LGA of Cross River and Tiv settlers in Cross River State. Nine (9) people were also abducted and several properties including houses burnt down in the incident. The violent boundary clashes started about two months ago when the Tiv settlers allegedly refused to continue the payments of royalties for their stay on Yache lands.
- Location: Yache-Ijiegu Community in Yala LGA of Cross River
- Casualty [Male& female]: Twenty people killed, nine others abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties including houses burnt down/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the

- Location: Lokpanta Regional Cattle Market in Umunneochi LGA of Abia State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: 50 decomposing and 20 headless bodies uncovered.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the affected area. Also, the State Governor, had stated that his administration had introduced technology in the fight against insecurity in the state, and vowed to sustain the heat against criminals until total peace and security were restored1.

- Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED BOKO HARAM TERRORISTS
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 30/10/2023
- Description of Incident: Twenty (20) people were allegedly killed and four (4) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram terrorists at Gurokayeya Village in Geidam LGA of Yobe State. Further investigations have revealed that victims were murdered over failure to pay their taxes to terrorists in the area.
- Location: Gurokayeya Village in Geidam LGA of Yobe State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Twenty males killed, four males injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is on ongoing security clearance operation in the state to strengthen peace and security.

The Taraba State Governor, Agbu Kefas, had placed a ban on all forms of mining activities in the state and set up a mobile court to try violators of the executive order<sup>2</sup>

- Description of Incident: Twenty-one (21) people including children and women were allegedly killed and two (2) others injured following Improvised Explosive Device (IED) explosion planted by Boko Haram terrorists at Goni Mittiri Village Near Gumsa Town in Geidam LGA of Yobe State. Further investigations have revealed that the explosion occurred while they returned from a funeral ceremony of victims earlier killed by terrorists on October 30, 2023 in the LGA.
- Location: Goni Mittiri Village Near Gumsa Town in Geidam LGA of Yobe State.
- Casualty [Male&female]: Twenty people including children and women killed, two people (1 male, 1 female) injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation in the State to counter terrorist attacks and also strengthen peace and security in the affected area.

- Title of Incident: ROBBERY/VANDALISM
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence:31/10/2023
