- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 10/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Four (4) people were reportedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Dungwel Community in Mangu LGA of Plateau State. The residence of the village head was also destroyed in the incident.
- Location: Dungwel Community in Mangu LGA of Plateau State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Four people killed, several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: One residential building destroyed/community residents.
- **♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the Nigerian Army have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected community.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low
- **Date of Occurrence:** 10/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Seven (7) people including local vigilantes were reportedly killed and three (3) others injured in a foiled kidnap attempt by suspected armed gang at Oba Area in Idemili North LGA of Anambra State.
- Location: Oba Area in Idemili North LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Seven males killed, three males injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/local vigilantes, community residents.
- **♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses:**The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area.

- **Date of Occurrence:** 10/12/2023
- **♣ Description of Incident:** A traditional ruler was reportedly abducted and his aide killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Akpabuyo LGA of Cross River State.

- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed, one male abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/monarch, community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigation to rescue of the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Description of Incident:** A student of the Delta State Polytechnic was reportedly shot dead by his landlord at Otefe-Oghara Area in Ethiope West LGA of Delta State. The reason behind the incident is unknown.
- Location: Otefe-Oghara Area in Ethiope West LGA of Delta State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **♣ Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/student.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the perpetrator of the crime for further investigation.

Incident N*5:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 10/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Thirty (30) residents were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Unguwar Liman Village in Gwada Community, Igabi LGA of Kaduna State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Unguwar Liman Village in Gwada Community, Igabi LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Thirty people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter bandits' activities in the State and rescue the abducted victims.

- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/private security guard.

- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Six people (4 military operatives, 2 males) killed, two males abducted.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: Vehicle damaged and firearms stolen/military operatives, community members, South Korean expatriates.
