Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION/ARREST

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/12/2023

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly rescued thirteen (13) abducted victims during a search and rescue operation conducted at Dansadau Axis in Maru LGA of Zamfara State. The operatives also destroyed several bandits' enclaves in the operation.

Location: Dansadau Axis in Maru LGA of Zamfara State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several bandits' enclaves destroyed/community residents, suspected bandits.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/THREAT

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/12/2023

Description of Incident: Members of the Ambazonia rebel group from Cameroun Republic reportedly carried out an attack at Okwa Community in Boki LGA of Cross River State. The suspects allegedly threatened the residents and restricted them from accessing their farmlands.

Location: Okwa Community in Boki LGA of Cross River State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: Efforts are ongoing by the Federal Government to strengthen security at border communities.

Title of Incident: MANSLAUGHTER/SUICIDE

Date of Occurrence: 17/12/2023

Description of Incident: A police operative reportedly killed himself after accidentally shooting a police operative dead in an attempt to arrest a resisting suspect at Nyogor-Lueku Community in Khana LGA of Rivers State.

Location: Nyogor-Lueku Community in Khana LGA of Rivers State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two police operatives dead.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/police operatives.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigation to ascertain the circumstances surrounding the incident.
