- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION/ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: Medium
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 3/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Five (5) people were reportedly killed and several others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Kojiyo Ward in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Kojiyo Ward in Goronyo LGA of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Five people killed, several people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is no intervention as of reporting time.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Medium
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 3/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Nine (9) people were reportedly killed in separate attacks carried out by suspected ethnic Fulani militia gang at Anyiin, Ayilamo, Iorza and Gbeji Communities in Logo LGA of Benue State. The unabated attacks allegedly commenced on November 29, 2023.
- Location: Anyiin, Ayilamo, Iorza and Gbeji Communities in Logo LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Nine people killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected areas.

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 3/12/2023,
- ♣ Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Asokoro Extension Axis in Abuja-FCT. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motion behind the crime.
- Location: Asokoro Extension Axis in Abuja-FCT.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The Vigilante Group of Nigeria (VGN) has commenced efforts to rescue the abducted victims.

- Title of Incident: ACCIDENTAL AIRSTRIKE 1
- Scale of incident: High
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 3/12/2023
- Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed about 85 community residents including women and injured 66 others in airstrikes conducted at Tudun Biri Village in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State. Further information revealed that the Nigerian Army was on a routine mission against terrorists but inadvertently affected members of the community. Residents of the affected communities were reportedly celebrating Maulud, an Islamic event when the bombs were dropped by the military, a development that triggered both local and international condemnation².
- Location: Tudun Biri Village in Igabi LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Eighty-five people killed, sixty-six people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties damaged/community residents.
- 4 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*5:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 4/12/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly killed a suspected member of the Indigenous People of Biafra/Eastern Security Network (IPOB/ESN) in a security raid conducted at a criminal hideout at Umogu Amuzu Community in Aboh-Mbaise LGA of Imo State. One AK-47 rifle and 19 rounds of live ammunition were recovered in the operation.
- Location: Umogu Amuzu Community in Aboh-Mbaise LGA of Imo State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One suspected IPOB/ESN member killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/ESN members.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There are ongoing security clearance operations to counter criminal activities in the State.

Incident N*6:

- Title of Incident: ARREST OF SUSPECTED DRUG TRAFFICKERS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 4/12/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested four (4) suspected drug traffickers in a security raid conducted at Unguwar Mai Community in Makarfi LGA of Kaduna State. 50 kilogrammes (kg) of Indian hemp and a firearm were recovered in the operation.
- Location: Unguwar Mai Community in Makarfi LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected drug traffickers.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/NSCDC operative, private security guards.
