- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED BANDITS
- Scale of incident: Low
- 4 Date of Occurrence: 14/1/2024
- Description of Incident: Suspected armed bandits reportedly attacked a military camp and set ablaze several vehicles at Nahuta Village in Batsari LGA of Katsina State. The attackers also burgled shops and carted away with properties and domestic animals in the incident.
- Location: Nahuta Village in Batsari LGA of Katsina State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Vehicles set ablaze/Operatives of the Nigerian Army.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
