- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 24/12/2023
- **♣ Description of Incident:** No fewer than 195 people were reportedly killed, over 300 others injured and over 10,000 people displaced in coordinated attacks carried out by suspected armed gangs at several communities in Bokkos, Mangu and Barkin Ladi LGAs of Plateau State. No fewer than 1,290 houses, several vehicles and motorcycles were also set ablaze in the attacks by the suspects.
- Location: Bokkos, Mangu and Barkin Ladi LGAs of Plateau State
- Casualty [Male & female]: One hundred and ninety-five people killed, three hundred people injured.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: Several vehicles, motorcycles and over 1,290 houses destroyed/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected communities.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 24/12/2023
- Description of Incident: Two (2) people including an erstwhile Vice Chairman of Yorro LGA and a businessman were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Dila Village in Yorro LGA of Taraba State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Dila Village in Yorro LGA of Taraba State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed for search and rescue of the abducted victims and to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*3:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARREST
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 24/12/2023
- ♣ Description of Incident: A traditional monarch was reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Akutara Area in Adani Community, Uzo Uwani LGA of Enugu State. The motive behind the crime is unknown.
- Location: Akutara Area in Adani Community, Uzo Uwani LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/traditional monarch, suspected hoodlums.
