- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 7/1/2024
- **Description of Incident:** Seven (7) people were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Arufu, Chembe and Mchia Communities, Gaamber-Tiev in Logo LGA of Benue State. The motive behind the attack is unknown.
- **Location:** Arufu, Chembe and Mchia Communities, Gaamber-Tiev in Logo LGA of Benue State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Seven people killed.
- ₽ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣** Date of Occurrence: 7/1/2024
- Description of Incident: Ten (10) people including a female teenager were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Sagwari Layout Estate in Dutse Axis of the FCT, Abuja. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- **Location:** Sagwari Layout Estate in Dutse Axis of the FCT, Abuja.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Ten people (including a female teenager) abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and forestall further attacks in the area.
