Title of Incident: SHOOTING/ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 4/2/2024

- Description of Incident: An operative of the Nigerian Army was reportedly killed, and several others injured in a shooting incident by an operative of the Nigerian Army at the Forward Operational Base in Magami Area of Sokoto State. According to media reports, the military operative went berserk and opened fire on his colleagues before being gunned down by other soldiers present at the scene.
- Location: Forward Operational Base in Magami Area of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Two male military operatives killed, several military operatives injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property destroyed/Nigerian Army operatives.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured military operatives have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK/ABDUCTION BY TERRORISTS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 4/2/2024

- Description of Incident: Two (2) construction workers were reportedly killed, and three (3) hunters abducted in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram terrorists at Kukareta Village, along Maiduguri Road in Damaturu LGA of Yobe State. The attackers also burnt down a house and vehicle belonging to the District Head.
- Location: Kukareta Village, along Maiduguri Road in Damaturu LGA of Yobe State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two males killed, three males abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: A house and car burnt/construction workers, District Head, community members.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
