Essential Responsibilities

- Support program implementation and ensure all programs are responsive to communities and partners, and consistent with WANEP-Nigeria's relevant program guidelines, principles, values, quality standards and strategic plan.
- Ensure all program documents are properly filed and archived both physically and electronically in adherence to internal and donor regulations with support from the MEL department.
- Support in organizing meetings, preparing agendas and minutes of meetings.
- Works closely with the MEL Officer, CARM Officer and Operations staff (including finance and operations) to ensure that activities are implemented according to schedule, budget and required quality.
- Submit monthly and weekly program updates including success stories from program intervention sites.
- Support the Programs and MEL departments in the maintenance of effective program reporting and monitoring and evaluation systems (to track, analyse and report on results) for both internal and external use.



- Support the functioning of community-based Early Warning Early Response (EWER) system including consideration of gender and vulnerable groups.
- Support the integration of community approaches, gender sensitivity and capacity building into all activities as appropriate. Ensure all interventions adhere to WANEP-Nigeria's Gender Policy, Do No Harm principles, and beneficiary accountability standards.
- Coordinate with procurement, logistics, security, administration, and human resources teams to ensure operational systems support field activities.
