- 4 Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 10/3/2024
- Description of Incident: Several people were reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected hoodlums during the traditional procession rite of a monarch in Agosasa Community, Ipokia LGA of Ogun State. Further investigations have revealed that the attack occurred following an existing Kingship tussle in the community.
- Location: Agosasa Community in Ipokia LGA of Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Several people injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/traditional monarch and community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The swift response of security operatives led to the arrest of eighteen (18) suspected hoodlums in connection with the crime.
