- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 18/2/2024
- Description of Incident: About three (3) people and a corpse were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers at Umuoka Area in Udi LGA of Enugu State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Umuoka Area in Udi LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Three people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is no intervention as of reporting time.
