- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 25/2/2024
- Leave The National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) reportedly confirmed the arrest of three (3) port workers in connection with the seizure of two (2) containers containing 192.7 kilogrammes of Colorado, a pistol, and ammunition at the Tincan Seaport in Apapa LGA of Lagos State.
- Location: Tincan Seaport in Apapa LGA of Lagos State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected drug facilitators.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the NDLEA for further interrogation.

Incident N*2:

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED ARMED HERDERS
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 25/2/2024
