- **Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 3/3/2024
- **Description of Incident:** A journalist with Punch Newspaper was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnappers along Lagos-Ibadan Expressway in Ogun State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Lagos-Ibadan Expressway in Ogun State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: One male abducted.
- ♣ Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/Journalist.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victim and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
