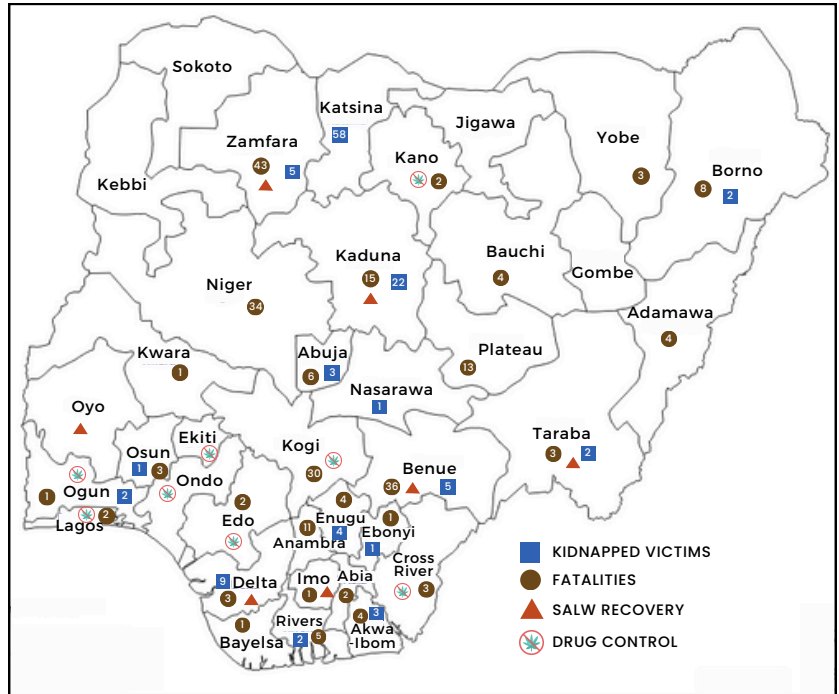
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

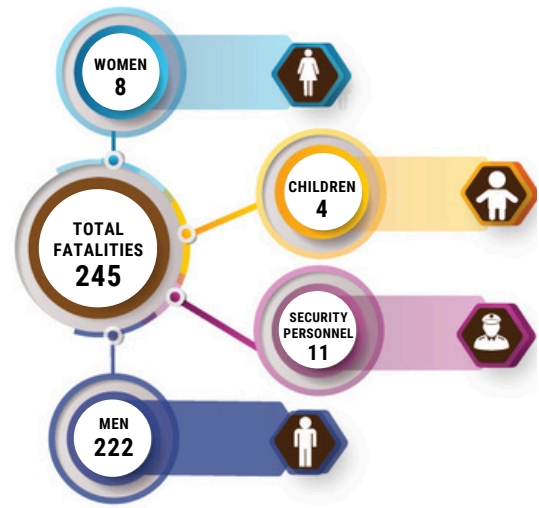
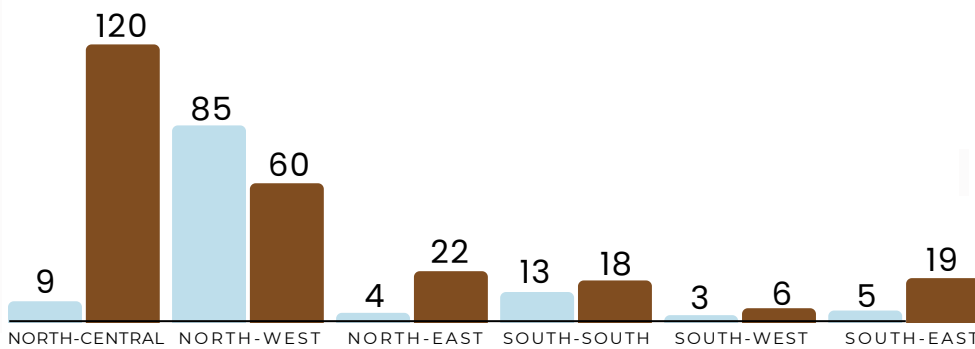
Within the reporting period, a total of 129 armed violence incidents were recorded with 107 injuries and 245 fatalities including 8 women, 4 children and 11 security personnel. The North-Central and North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 120 and 85, while the North-East and South-East accounted for 22 and 19 deaths. Also, the South-West and South-South recorded 18 and 6 deaths respectively in the reporting period. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

The WANEP NEWS also recorded 21 incidents of kidnapping across 15 States with 119 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 119 kidnapped victims, 12 were women and 37 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and South-South accounted for the highest number with 85 and 13, followed by the North-Central and South-East with 9 and 5 kidnapped victims while the North-East and South-West recorded 4 and 3 in the reporting period.

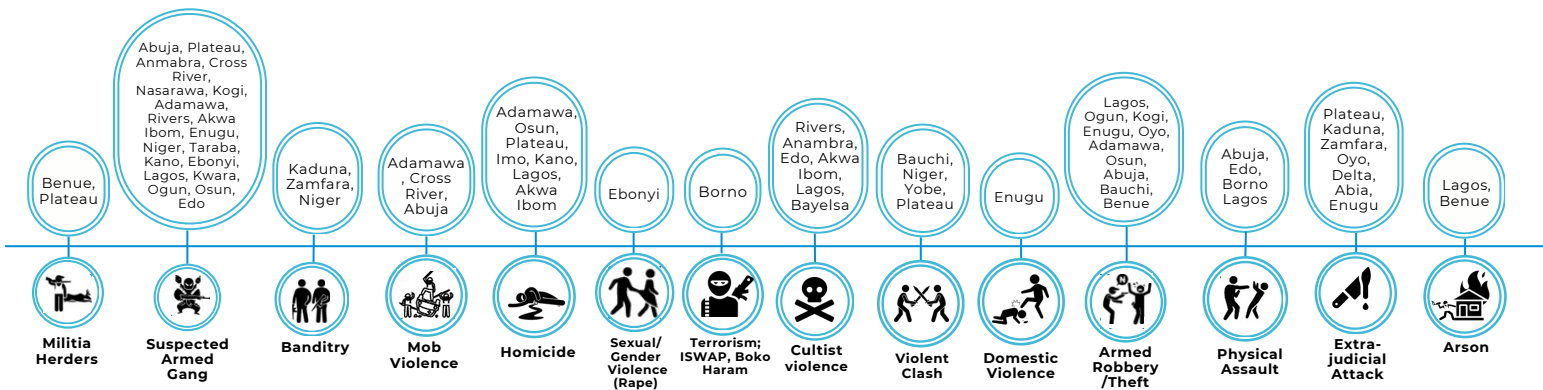
AFFECTED LOCATIONS
