Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army and local vigilantes reportedly arrested a suspected gunrunner and recovered 2 firearms in a security operation conducted at Jalingo Motor Park in Jalingo LGA of Taraba State.

Location: Jalingo Motor Park in Jalingo LGA of Taraba State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected gunrunner.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspect is in the custody of the Nigerian Army for further interrogation.

 Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.


 Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Casualty [Male & female]: Ten suspected terrorists killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Two vehicles destroyed/suspected ISWAP terrorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter terrorists' activities in the State.
