- ♣ Scale of incident: Medium
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 17/3/2024
- → **Description of Incident:** Eighty-seven (87) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Dogon-Noma Community in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State. Several shops including food items and valuables were reportedly looted by the attackers. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
- Location: Dogon-Noma Community in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: 87 people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several shops including food items and valuables looted/community residents
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
