Title of Incident: CULT VIOLENCE

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 31/3/2024

Description of Incident: A suspected cultist was reportedly killed by a suspected rival cult gang in an attack carried out at Ijeun Tuntun Axis in Abeokuta South LGA of Ogun State. Supremacy tussle and revenge attacks have been attributed as the motive behind cult violence.

Location: Ijeun Tuntun Axis in Abeokuta South LGA of Ogun State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected cultist.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have commenced investigation to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Incident N*2:

Title of Incident: LOOTING/SHOOTING

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 31/3/2024

Description of Incident: A truck conveying foodstuff and several warehouses were reportedly looted by community residents at Bayan Kara Area in Birnin Kebbi LGA of Kebbi State. The operatives of the Nigerian Army deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area reportedly shot dead a shop owner in an altercation that occurred following allegations of looting.

Location: Bayan Kara Area in Birnin Kebbi LGA of Kebbi State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several foodstuff stolen/community residents, warehouse operators, State Government.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Government has instituted measures to prevent a reoccurrence of the event.

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 31/3/2024

Description of Incident: Five (5) people were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Adija Community in Apa LGA of Benue State.

Location: Adija Community in Apa LGA of Benue State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Five people killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of security agencies have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the LGA.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two people killed, two people injured.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several houses destroyed/community residents.

 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The injured victims have been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

 **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/UNIMAID lecturer, suspected assailants.

 **Location:** Etobaba Area in Jos North LGA of Plateau State.

 **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male killed.


 **Property damaged/Affected population:** A poultry farm, a house and a car destroyed; 2000 poultry birds stolen/poultry farm owners and staff.


 **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the affected area.

Description of Incident: Five (5) people including a police operative and four (4) suspects were reportedly killed and several others injured in a gun duel between operatives of the State Police Command and suspected armed gang during a security raid at Aguluezechukwu, Aguata and Ogboji Areas in Orumba South LGA of Anambra State. Several locally fabricated rocket launchers, charms, and police uniforms were recovered.

Location: Aguluezechukwu, Aguata and Ogboji Areas in Orumba South LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Five people killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Criminal hideouts destroyed/suspected armed gang.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to apprehend the fleeing members of the suspected armed gang.

Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly shot dead by a local hunter for an unknown reason at Latico Area in Iwo LGA of Osun State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC) have arrested the perpetrator of the crime for further interrogation.

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 2/4/2024

Description of Incident: Five (5) male kidnapped victims were reportedly killed, two (2) others injured, and 51 victims released by suspected armed bandits following ransom payments in Kajuru LGA of Kaduna State. Preliminary findings revealed that the released victims were abducted three (3) weeks prior.
