- Description of Incident: The operatives of the State Police Command reportedly arrested 307 criminal suspects including fourteen (14) females in a security raid conducted at Dei-Dei -Zuba Axis in Abuja-FCT. Pistols, illicit drug substances and other weapons were recovered in the operation.
- Location: Dei-Dei -Zuba Axis in Abuja-FCT.
- Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/criminal suspects.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Police Command for further interrogation.

- Location: Jibia-Batsari Road in Jibia LGA of Katsina State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Ten people killed, several people injured, several people abducted
- Property damaged/Affected population: Two vehicles destroyed/traders, community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.
