- ♣ Date of Occurrence: 12/5/2024
- **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Department of State Services (DSS) and local vigilantes were reportedly injured and several abducted students rescued during security operation at the hideouts of suspected kidnappers at Osara Axis in Okene LGA of Kogi State.
- Location: Osara Axis in Okene LGA of Kogi State.
- **Casualty [Male& female]:** Several security operatives and local vigilantes injured.
