The failure of parents to present their children for medical treatment have been attributed as the cause of the disease spread and mortality rate.
- Location: Mubi North LGA of Adamawa State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Nineteen minors dead, two hundred minors infected.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The State Ministry of Health has dispatched health personnel to the affected areas for effective response and mitigation efforts.
