- **Description of Incident:** Four (4) people were allegedly killed and several others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed herders at Nimbo Community in Uzo-Uwani LGA of Enugu State.
- Location: Nimbo Community in Uzo-Uwani LGA of Enugu State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Four males killed, several others injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

The CJTF chairman for Gamboru Ngala area near the border with Cameroon, Tijjanima Umar, stated that his teams were travelling to Maiduguri Axis of Borno state capital when they drove over the IED<sup>1</sup>.

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to restore normalcy in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ARSON BY SUSPECTED ARMED GANG
- Scale of incident: Medium
- Date of Occurrence: 1/5/2024
- **♣ Description of Incident:** Eleven (11) people including children and females were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Inikiri Effium Community in Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State<sup>2</sup>. The deceased included a pregnant woman, children between the ages of 2 and 12, aged men and women. A Primary Healthcare Center built for the community by an international organisation, and over 30 residential houses were set ablaze during the attack. The cause of the attack is unknown
- Location: Inikiri Effium Community in Ohaukwu LGA of Ebonyi State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: Eleven people (including children and females) killed.
- Property damaged/Affected population: 30 buildings and a health centre set ablaze/community resident.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

- Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK/ABDUCTION
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 1/5/2024
- Description of Incident: A former chairmanship candidate of the All Progressives Congress (APC) in Kuje Area Council of FCT-Abuja was allegedly killed and three (3) others including his son and sibling abducted in an attack carried out by suspected gang in Kuje Area Council in Abuja, FCT.
- Location: Kuje Area Council in FCT-Abuja.
- Casualty [Male& female]: One male killed, three males abducted.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to rescue the abducted victims and apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

### **Incident N\*28:**

- Title of Incident: SHOOTING BY A POLICE OFFICER/ARSON
- Scale of incident: Low
- Date of Occurrence: 1/5/2024
- Description of Incident: A male resident was reportedly shot dead by a police officer following a disagreement at a fuel station at Obalende, Ikoyi Area in Lagos Island LGA of Lagos State. Angered by the incident, some of the youths at the fuel station set ablaze two (2) Hilux vans belonging to security operatives. Further investigation has revealed that the victim was shot while resisting the police officer from jumping the queue.
