Description of Incident: Three (3) officials of the Zamfara State-owned Community Protection Guard (CPG) were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Jambako Area in Maradun LGA of Zamfara State.

Location: Jambako Area in Maradun LGA Area of Zamfara State.

Casualty [Male& female]: Three state security guards killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/security guards.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.

Date of Occurrence: 5/5/2024

Description of Incident: Thirteen (13) people were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at Piko Community in Bwari Area Council in Abuja, FCT. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime.
