✚ **Title of Incident:** VANDALISM/MOB ACTION

✚ **Scale of incident:** Low

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 9/6/2024

✚ **Description of Incident:** Two (2) suspected cable thieves were reportedly beaten and injured by community residents who apprehended them following the vandalism and theft of electric cables at Amuloko Area in Ona-Ara LGA of Oyo State.

✚ **Location:** Amuloko Area in Ona-Ara LGA of Oyo State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Two male suspects injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Electric cables vandalized/suspected cable thieves, community residents.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested the suspects for further interrogation.

✚ **Description of Incident:** The operatives of the Nigerian Air Force (NAF) reportedly killed an undisclosed number of suspected Islamic State of West Africa Province (ISWAP) terrorists and destroyed three (3) suicide vehicle-borne explosive devices (VBEDs) in an air interdiction mission conducted at Kollaram Area in Borno State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Several suspected terrorists killed.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Three VBEDs destroyed/suspected ISWAP terrorists.

✚ **Scale of incident:** High

✚ **Date of Occurrence:** 9/6/2024

✚ **Description of Incident:** About 46 people including four (4) police operatives and two (2) members of the Katsina State Community Watch Corps were reportedly killed and two (2) others injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Gidan Tofa and Dan Nakwabo Village in Kankara LGA of Katsina State. Several properties were also destroyed by the suspects.

✚ **Location:** Gidan Tofa and Dan Nakwabo Village in Kankara LGA of Katsina State.

✚ **Casualty [Male & female]:** Forty-six people (including four police operatives) killed, two people injured.

✚ **Property damaged/Affected population:** Several properties destroyed/community residents, police operatives, Katsina State Community Watch Corps members.

✚ **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the area.

✚ **Description of Incident:** About eighteen (18) people in a bus were reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Ughell-Patani Road in Delta State.

✚ Description of Incident: Several structures within the Plateau State Specialists Hospital were reportedly destroyed in a rainstorm at Jos Area of Plateau State.

✚ Location: Jos Area of Plateau State.

✚ Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

✚ Property damaged/Affected population: Several structures destroyed/medical practitioners, community residents.

✚ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Government has commenced efforts to rebuild the damaged structures at the hospital.

✚ Title of Incident: CHOLERA OUTBREAK

✚ Scale of incident: Medium

✚ Date of Occurrence: 15/6/2024

✚ Description of Incident: The Lagos State Government has confirmed the death of 15 people and 350 suspected cases in an outbreak of Cholera sub-type O-1 at 29 Wards in Lagos State. The storage and consumption of food and water under unsanitary conditions have been highlighted as the cause of the spread of the disease.

✚ Location: 29 Wards in Lagos State.

✚ Casualty [Male & female]: 15 people dead, 350 people infected.

✚ Property damaged/Affected population: No property destroyed/community residents.

✚ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Ministry of Health has activated its Public Health Emergency Operations Centre (PHEOC), Yaba to treat infected residents. Also, the Ministry has commenced the distribution of Oral Rehydration Solutions while also embarking on public health campaigns.
