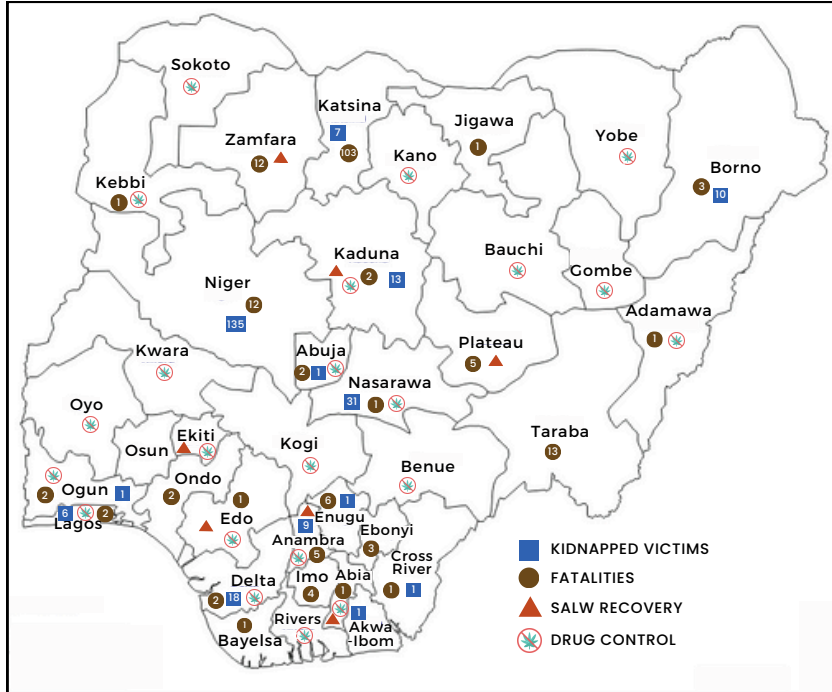
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

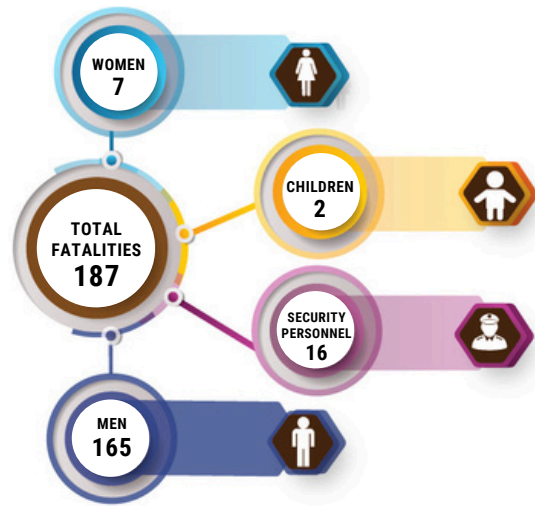
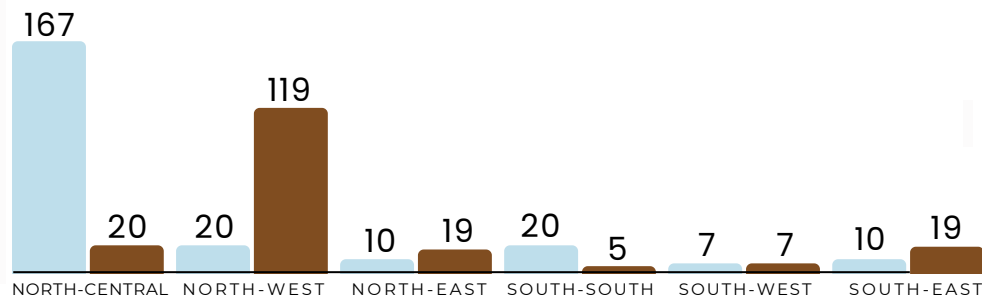
Within the reporting period, a total of 115 armed violence incidents were recorded with 64 injuries and 187 fatalities including 7 women, 2 children and 16 security personnel. The North-West recorded the highest number of fatalities with 119, while the North-Central and South-East accounted for 20 and 19 deaths respectively. Also, the North-East and South-West recorded 17 and 7 deaths respectively with 5 deaths reported in the South-South in the reporting period. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

The WANEP NEWS also recorded 21 incidents of kidnapping across 13 States with 234 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 234 kidnapped victims, 5 were women 2 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-Central accounted for the highest number with 167, followed by the North-West and South-South with 20 kidnapped victims each. Also, the South-East and North-East recorded 10 kidnapped victims each, while the South-West accounted for 7 in the reporting period.

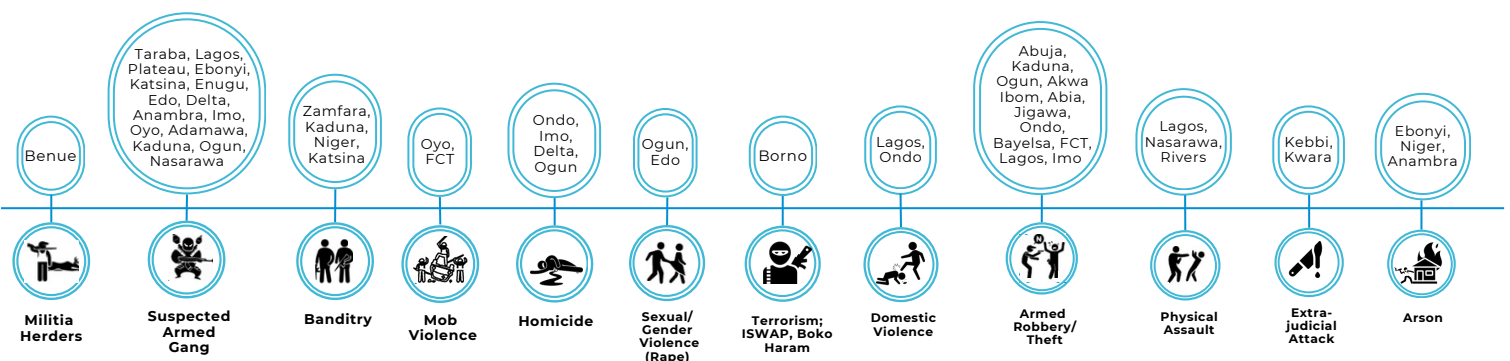
AFFECTED LOCATIONS
