- Description of Incident: Six (6) people were reportedly killed while others injured and abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Tudun Doki Village in Gwadabawa LGA of Sokoto
- **Location:** Tudun Doki Village in Gwadabawa LGA of Sokoto State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: Six people killed, several people injured, several people abducted.
- Property damaged/Affected population: Several properties damaged/community residents.
- ♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed for investigation and strengthen security in the affected area.

### Incident N\*88:

- Title of Incident: CHOLERA OUTBREAK
- Scale of incident: High
- Date of Occurrence: 19/6/2024
- Description of Incident: The Lagos State Government has confirmed the death of 9 people, 76 new suspected cases and 35 confirmed cases in an outbreak of cholera at 29 Wards in 20 LGAs of Lagos State with Lagos Island, Kosofe and Eti Osa LGAs recording the highest numbers of cases. The additional figures give a total of 24 deaths, 417 suspected Cholera cases, and 35 confirmed cases in the State. Cholera is a food and water-borne disease caused by ingesting Vibrio Cholerae bacteria in contaminated water and food.
- Location: 29 Wards in 20 LGAs of Lagos State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** Three people dead, 35 confirmed infected cases.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Ministry of Health has activated its Public Health Emergency Operations Centre (PHEOC), Yaba to treat infected residents. Also, the Ministry has commenced the distribution of Oral Rehydration Solutions while also embarking on public health campaigns.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is no reported intervention as of reporting time.
