- ♣ Description of Incident: A police operative was reportedly killed, and his house set ablaze in an attack carried out by a suspected armed gang at Mairi Community in Buni Yadi, Gujba LGA of Yobe State.
- Location: Mairi Community in Buni Yadi, Gujba LGA of Yobe State.
- **Casualty [Male & female]:** One male police operative killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** One house destroyed/police operative.
- ♣ Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced efforts to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
