- **Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED CULT MEMBERS**
- Scale of incident: Low
- **♣ Date of Occurrence:** 7/7/2024
- **Description of Incident:** A suspected cult member was allegedly killed in a violent clash between suspected rival cult gangs 'Eiye and Aiye' confraternity at Iwo Road in Ibadan of Oyo State.
- **Location:** Iwo Road in Ibadan of Oyo State.
- Casualty [Male& female]: One male killed.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/suspected cult member.
- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The security operatives have been deployed to forestall further attacks in the area.

Incident N*02:

- **Date of Occurrence:** 7/7/2024
