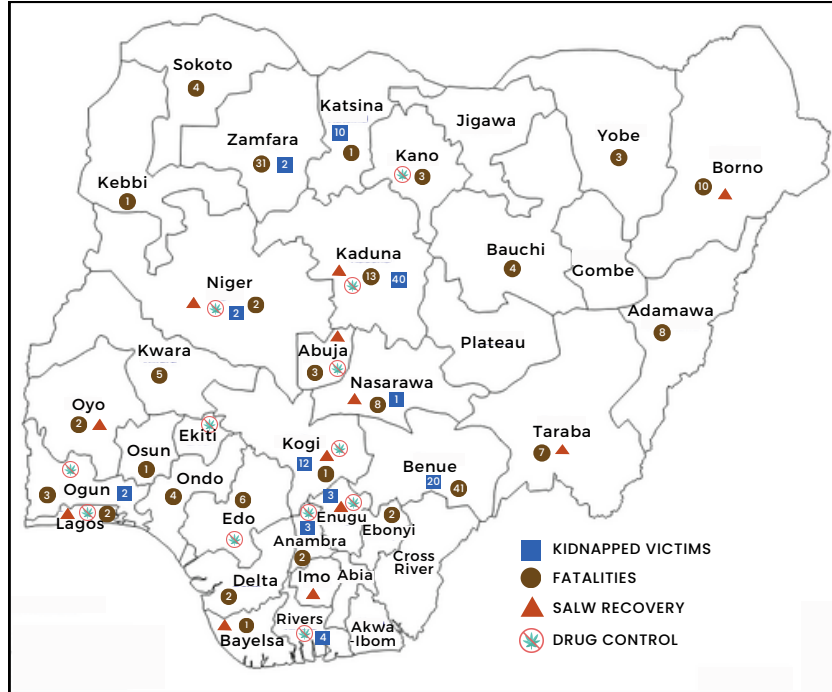
SUMMARY

The situation report, which provides a bi-weekly update on armed violence incidents and casualties in Nigeria, documented multiple security threats including terrorist-related attacks, banditry, kidnapping, cult clashes, and communal clashes including community-herder clashes as well as Sexual and Gender-Based Violence (SGBV), particularly rape in the reporting period.

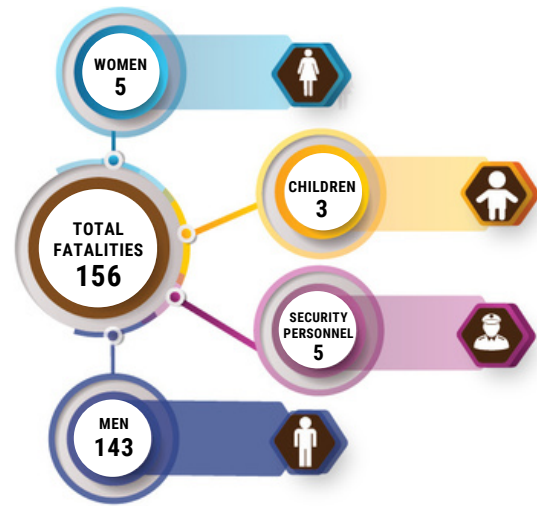
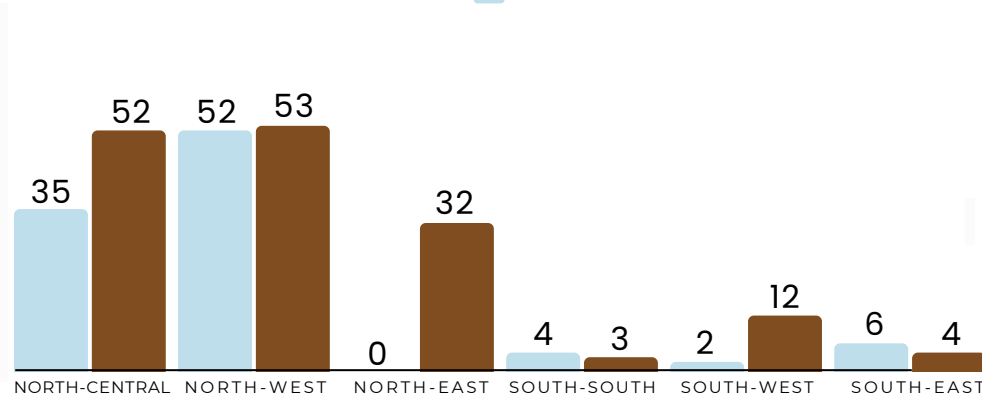
Within the reporting period, a total of 125 armed violence incidents were recorded with 82 injuries and 156 fatalities including 5 women, 3 children and 5 security personnel. The North-West and North-Central recorded the highest number of fatalities with 53 and 52, while the North-East accounted for 32 deaths. Also, the South-West, South-East and South-South recorded 12, 4 and 3 respectively in the reporting period. Non-state armed actors are not included in the statistics of recorded fatalities.

The WANEP NEWS also recorded 17 incidents of kidnapping across 12 States with 99 people abducted in the reporting period. Out of the 99 kidnapped victims, 4 were women and 6 children. Further analysis reveals that the North-West and North-Central accounted for the highest number with 52 and 35, followed by the South-East and South-South with 6 and 4 kidnapped victims. The South-West had 2 incidents, while the North-East reported no incidents of kidnapping in the reporting period.

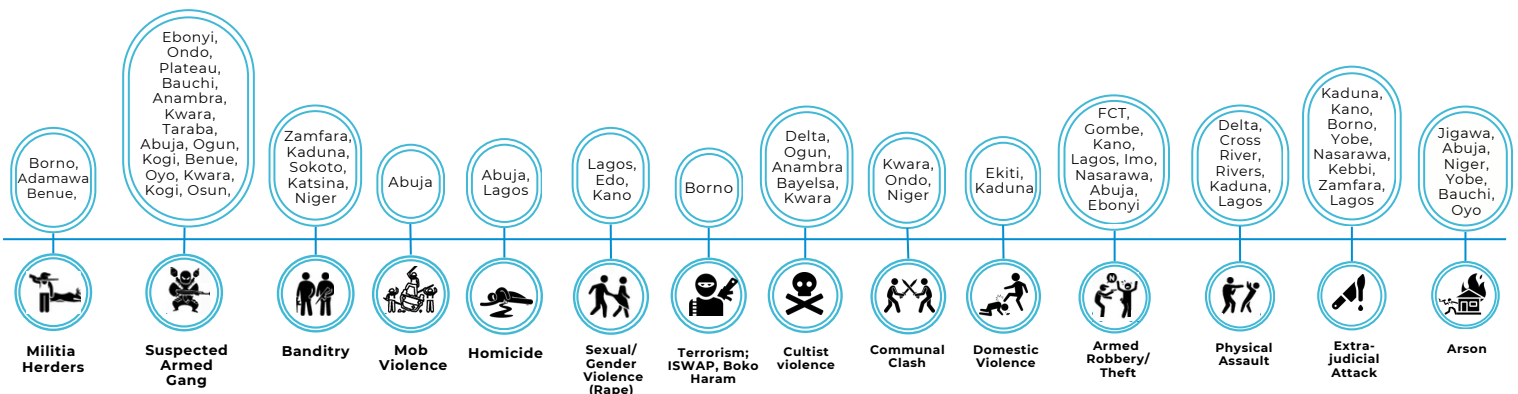
AFFECTED LOCATIONS
