Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK BY SUSPECTED HOODLUMS

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 21/7/2024

Description of Incident: Four (4) people including a police officer were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang along Ngwa Road in Abia State. Two suspected hoodlums were also killed by the police operatives in the attack. The police operatives were reportedly ambushed while on a security patrol in the area.

Location: Ngwa Road in Abia State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Six males including a police officer killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents and a police officer.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: Swift response of the security operatives led to the killing of the two armed gang in the incident.

Date of Occurrence: 21/7/2024

Description of Incident: A male applicant vying for a spot in the Nigerian Army was reportedly stabbed to death by his colleague and the sum of eight hundred thousand stolen from his account at PZ Area in Sabon-Gari LGA of Kaduna State

Location: PZ Area in Sabon-Gari LGA of Kaduna State

Casualty [Male&female]: One male killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community resident.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have commenced investigations into the incident.
