Title of Incident: ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 28/7/2024

Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army reportedly killed eight (8) suspected terrorists during security operation in Bula Marwa Area, Siraja Village in Borno State. Several arms and ammunition, a pair of desert camouflage and uniforms were recovered from the suspects.

Location: Bula Marwa Area, Siraja Village in Borno State.

Casualty [Male& female]: Eight suspected Boko Haram terrorists killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Several arms and ammunition, a pair of desert camouflage and uniforms were recovered/suspected Boko haram terrorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to strengthen peace and security in the State.

Incident N*02:

Title of Incident: VIOLENT EXTREMIST ATTACK

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 28/7/2024

Description of Incident: Two (2) people including a police officer and a female were reportedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected Boko Haram terrorists in a police station at Jakana Area in Konduga LGA of Borno State. Two police vehicles were burnt down with arms and ammunition carted away by the attackers.

Location: Jakana Area in Konduga LGA of Borno State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Two people (including a police officer and one female) killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: Two police vehicles burnt down, arms and ammunition carted away/suspected Boko Haram terrorists.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: There is an ongoing security operation to counter the activities of terrorists in the State.

Incident N*03:

Title of Incident: CLASH/VANDALISM

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 28/7/2024

Description of Incident: Five (5) vehicles and the provost's quarters were reportedly vandalized by staff and students at the Federal College of Education Technical (FCET), Akoka in Shomolu LGA of Lagos State. The incident reportedly occurred during the visit of a team from the Ministry of Education on a mission to resolve the 3-month-long impasse between staff members and the provost. **Location:** Akoka in Shomolu LGA of Lagos State.

Casualty [Male& female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: Five vehicles and provost's quarters vandalized/staff members and students.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command reportedly arrested thirty-two (32) suspects allegedly attacking a Federal Government team on an inspection following the ongoing

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deployed to apprehend the perpetrators of the crime.
