Description of Incident: The operatives of the Nigerian Army and the Ondo State Task Force reportedly arrested twelve (12) suspects over alleged involvement in illegal mining in Ondo State. Several mining equipments were recovered.

Location: Ondo State.

Casualty [Male & female]: No casualty reported.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/suspected illegal miners.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The arrested suspects are in the custody of the State Task Force for further

interrogation.
