- ♣ Description of Incident: An expatriate was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang at the Ogbunka Village in Orumba South LGA of Anambra State. Two (2) operatives of the State Police Command sustained injuries, and the abducted victim rescued in a swift security operation conducted to foil the attack.
- Location: Ogbunka Village in Orumba South LGA of Anambra State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male abducted, two police operatives injured.
- Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/expatriate, police operatives.

- **Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have commenced patrols to apprehend the suspected perpetrators of the crime and strengthen peace in the affected community.
