- Date of Occurrence: 13/10/2024
- Description of Incident: The Director General of the Zamfara State Community Protection Guards (CPG) was reportedly injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Kucheri Village in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara
- Location: Kucheri Village in Tsafe LGA of Zamfara State.
- Casualty [Male & female]: One male injured.
- **Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/CPG Director General.
- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The injured victim has been taken to the hospital for medical treatment.

Incident N*02:

- Title of Incident: ARSON/ARMED ATTACK
- Scale of incident: Low

- Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have arrested a suspected kidnapper for further investigation aimed at prosecution while efforts to restore peace and security are ongoing in the affected area.
