Title of Incident: ARMED ROBBERY/ARMED ACTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 20/10/2024

Description of Incident: A suspected armed robber was reportedly killed by a local security guard following a robbery attack on two (2) female residents at Ifite Area in Awka South LGA of Anambra State.

Location: Ifite Area in Awka South LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male & female]: One male suspect killed.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents, suspected armed robber.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The State Police Command has commenced investigations aimed at apprehending two (2) other fleeing suspects for prosecution.

Title of Incident: ARMED ATTACK

Scale of incident: Medium

Date of Occurrence: 20/10/2024

Description of Incident: Sixteen (16) people were reportedly killed and several other residents including a female injured in an attack carried out by suspected armed gang during a traditional festival at Nibo Community in Awka South LGA of Anambra State.

Location: Nibo Community in Awka South LGA of Anambra State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Sixteen people killed, several people injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community residents.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The operatives of the State Police Command have been deployed to apprehend the suspected perpetrators of the crime for prosecution.

Title of Incident: BANDITRY/ABDUCTION

Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 20/10/2024

Description of Incident: Two (2) people were reportedly killed and several other travellers including the State Coordinator of the Revenue Mobilization Allocation and Fiscal Commission (RMAFC) abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits along the Funtua-Gusau Road in Zamfara State. Kidnapping for ransom has been attributed as the motive behind the crime

Location: Funtua-Gusau Road in Zamfara State.

Casualty [Male & female]: Two males killed, several people abducted.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/community members.
