**Title of Incident: BANDITRY/ABDUCTION**

**Scale of incident: Medium**

**Date of Occurrence: 1/12/2024**

**Description of Incident:** Nine (9) people were reportedly killed, one (1) other injured, and several others abducted in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits at Dan Tudu Community in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State. Several valuables were also looted in the attack.

**Location:** Dan Tudu Community in Sabon Birni LGA of Sokoto State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** Nine people killed, one person injured, several people abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** Several valuables looted/community residents.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** There is an ongoing security clearance operation to counter bandits' activities in the State.

#### **Incident N\*2:**

**Title of Incident: ABDUCTION**

**Scale of incident: Low**

**Date of Occurrence: 1/12/2024**

**Description of Incident:** One (1) resident was reportedly abducted in an attack carried out by suspected kidnapers at Tudun Ghana Quarters in Malam Madori LGA of Jigawa State.

**Location:** Tudun Ghana Quarters in Malam Madori LGA of Jigawa State.

**Casualty [Male & female]:** One male abducted.

**Property damaged/Affected population:** No property damaged/community resident.

**Coping Mechanism/Responses:** The operatives of the State Police Command have rescued the abducted victim in a swift security operation.
