Scale of incident: Low

Date of Occurrence: 17/11/2024

Description of Incident: The operative of the Nigerian Army reportedly arrested a suspected gunrunner with arms and ammunition recovered during a security raid at Farin Lamba in Jos South LGA of Plateau State.

Location: Farin Lamba in Jos South LGA of Plateau State.

Casualty [Male&female]: No casualty reported.

Description of Incident: Four (4) officers of the Nigerian Security and Civil defence Corps (NSCDC) were allegedly killed in an attack carried out by suspected armed bandits in Farin-Kasa Area, Chikun LGA, Kaduna State. The security operatives also repel the attack and killed over fifty (50) suspected armed bandits, with several others injured. Investigations revealed that the security operatives were ambush while inspecting the National Grid installation in the area.

Location: Farin-Kasa Area of Chikun LGA of Kaduna State.

Casualty [Male&female]: Four NSCDC officers and fifty suspected armed bandits killed, several terrorists injured.

Property damaged/Affected population: No property damaged/NSCDC officers and suspected armed bandits.

Coping Mechanism/Responses: The security operatives have been deloyed to forestall further attacks in the area and apprehend the perpetarators of the crime.
